Career to date

- Ms Berg is deputy director for aviation in the European Commission and she heads the aviation safety unit since January 2025. Before she was for six years responsible for air traffic management when heading the Single European Sky unit. In this function she oversaw the SESAR Joint Undertaking and supervised the Eurocontrol Network Manager.
- From 2012 to 2018 Ms Berg dealt with maritime safety and the European Maritime Safety Agency in Lisbon. Her managerial career also included assignments for Copernicus, the EU's earth observation programme, and on energy policy.
- Before joining the European Commission in 1996 she worked as a management consultant with an international firm in Switzerland.
