**WP 4: Competency Development:
“Impact assessment (IA) training”**



Within the framework of the EU-funded Eastern Partnership and Central Asian Project a training course on impact assessment was held in Tbilisi from 08 to 10 October 2019.

The overall objective of the training was to provide civil aviation experts of Georgia with essential knowledge about the purpose of impact assessment, monitoring and evaluation at EU level.

Determining when and how a Member State action should be undertaken, reviewed or repealed is ultimately a political choice. The quality of these choices, however, can be improved if better regulation principles like impact assessment, monitoring,



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evaluation and consultation of stakeholders are followed when preparing, implementing and evaluating policies, measures and financial programmes. These principles are simply good management principles.

The training provided theoretical notions and practical exercises. The tools that were explained could be adapted to CAA needs: in this regard, part of the time was dedicated for a case study customised for the participants.

The core modules of the course covered the following items:

- Steps of IA concepts
- How is IA integrated in EASA
 - Support for the EPAS process
 - Best Intervention Strategy concept
- Tools to support IA
- Monitoring and Evaluation concepts
- Case Study

21 civil aviation professionals from CAA Georgia and 3 experts from the Ministry of Economy and Sustainable Development of Georgia attended the course with high level of commitment.



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
