Within the framework of the EU-funded EASA - EaP/CA project in the Eastern Partnership and Central Asian countries, a Compliance Monitoring workshop was delivered in Tbilisi, Georgia from 27 to 29 November 2018.

The main objective of this workshop was to reinforce the participants' knowledge and understanding of skills necessary to manage, plan, conduct and report a wide range of audits in support of regulatory compliance.

The workshop was conducted using a combination of theoretical training, facilitated discussion, and case studies reviewed as group exercises to re-enforce the learning.
