The training objective of this specific delivery was to provide a hands-on practical expertise to airworthiness inspections and to introduce the concept of operational approvals focused on practical aspects and more specifically, to enable the trainees to participate in evaluation teams for granting operational approvals and at the same time to provide them with references to the guidance material that the current legislation contemplates.

The workshop enabled the NAA's experts to better understand the airworthiness requirements and internal procedures to be followed for the issuance of Operational Approvals, focusing on practical cases and in understanding the different concepts involved, with special emphasis on airworthiness.

This interactive activity brought together in Minsk 12 participants from the Civil Aviation Administrations of Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus and Moldova.
