On-the-Job training for OPS Inspectors



Within the framework of the EU-funded Eastern Partnership and Central Asia Project (EaP/CA), a five-day working session for OPS Inspectors was delivered from 3rd to 7th June 2019, in Vienna, Austria. The activity was attended by ten (10) subject matter experts from the civil aviation administrations (CAA) of Armenia, Azerbaijan, Moldova and Ukraine.

The objective of this activity was to provide both the theoretical and practical knowledge necessary for new CAA - OPS inspectors taking on their first roles within the authority, but it also served as a refresher for those who have been in their roles for some time but need to get updated.

The activity was developed in order to build inspectors capacity in the following areas:

- ✓ Identify and justify findings with regard to Air Operations according to the applicable European regulatory framework;
- ✓ Understand the roles of the European Union, EASA and the Member States;
- ✓ Understand the roles of the Chicago Convention, the International Civil Aviation Organization and the Contracting States;
- ✓ Understand the role of the Flight Operations Inspector;
- ✓ Understand the role of the holder of an Air Operator Certificate.
