

WP 4: Competency Development: “Workshop on EU Regulation 1178/2011 with focus on Part MED”

Within the framework of the EU-funded Eastern Partnership and Central Asian Project, a three day Workshop on EU Regulation 1178/2011, with focus on Part MED, was held in Kiev from 05 to 07 September 2018.



The overall objective of the workshop was related to the holders of medical certificates and organisations involved in medical certification of aircraft crew members. It enabled the participants from the civil aviation administrations to deepen their knowledge

regarding the applicable EU regulations, as well as to obtain practical knowledge via case studies including planning, performing and deciding on an audit of an aeromedical centre.

The information provided during the activity, and through open discussions with the participants, clarified the way the regulations are developed, the context of the regulations and how they should be implemented and handled.

Four civil aviation professionals from Armenia, Azerbaijan and Ukraine attended the workshop.
