WP 2: INITIATIVE FOR MIDDLE/LINE MANAGERS OF CAAs

Within the framework of the EU-funded EASA-IPA3 programme on aviation safety in the Western Balkans and Turkey, a course for the Middle and Line Management of civil aviation administrations was delivered in Podgorica from 07 to 10 June 2016. As part of a wider Management Initiative, this form of support is targeted at different levels of the Civil Aviation Authorities' (CAAs) Management, in order to: (1) refresh their skills and cultural understanding of the overall management system in civil aviation and (2) strengthen their management capabilities (requiring management commitment, skills and resources - be they technical, financial or business system-related) through the application of modern management tools. It is based on management experiences and good practices.

The aim of this interactive course was to enable Middle Managers and Technical Team Leaders in civil aviation administrations to: manage, lead, maintain, develop and support reforms in their national aviation safety system.

The course encompassed several different elements, including: the aviation regulatory landscape, management challenges, safety management system for authorities, mature authorities, culture in communities, management functions, regulatory excellence, process, people, policy, oversight, risk and performance, management tools as well as leadership and continuous professional development (CPD).

Twenty two (22) civil aviation professionals from the CAAs attended the course.
