WP 2: Safety analysis and occurrence reporting

On-site support activity to the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) of Kosovo*



Within the framework of the EU-funded EASA - IPA4 project, an on-site support activity on safety analysis and occurrence reporting was delivered to the CAA of Kosovo* from 18 to 21 March 2019.

The overall objective of this interactive working session was to review the current status of the safety analysing and occurrence reporting system, and to support the implementation of applicable rules and processes.

The activity encompassed support on implementation of the legal framework and on improvement of the authority's processes and procedures linked to management and evaluation of occurrence reports. Presentations on occurrence reporting elements (e.g. just culture, safety analysis, use of taxonomy, etc.) were delivered and discussed. EASA experts supported the installation and updates of the ECCAIRS software, taxonomy database and data analysis tools (AWB) and worked together with the CAA experts on concrete examples of data quality, coding guidelines, use of taxonomy, risk assessment (ERCS) and data analysis processes. This activity included also a short session with the aviation industry to introduce the concept of safety analysis and occurrence reporting.
