**WP 4: Competency Development:  
“OJT for EASA PART 145 Maintenance Organisation Approvals”**



A two-day On the Job Training course on EASA Part-145 – Maintenance Organisation Approvals was implemented in Madrid, Spain from 10 to 11 July 2018.

The course covered the following: gain knowledge of the key components of EASA Part-145; provide examples of “know how” as well as “know what” by looking at a practical perspective of Part-145; implementing Part-145 within an organisation; understanding of the interface between Part-145, Part-66 / Part-147 and EU-OPS; and, provide a regulatory and industry perspective for staff involved in Part-145 maintenance.

The course was conducted in classroom working sessions, which also included several case studies, group exercises and discussions, providing both the theoretical and practical knowledge necessary for new airworthiness inspectors to take on their first
