

1st June 2017**EASA-IPA 3 closure event in Albania**

The IPA3 Project reached its conclusion with a Steering Committee Meeting hosted by the Albanian Civil Aviation Authority in Tirana.

The project started in 2015, lasted for 2 years and was providing support to beneficiaries' countries in the Western Balkans and Turkey under the EU-funded IPA Programme.

The closure event brought together delegates from the Civil Aviation Authorities of the Western Balkan states, the EASA project team and the representative of the European Commission. An overview of all activities delivered during the lifespan of the project was provided and gave the opportunity to discuss the results achieved.

Since its beginning, some 170 aviation experts participated in the training sessions, workshops and country specific assistance support of the project. The feedback from the beneficiaries was very positive. All the participants were updated on the follow-up project EASA-IPA 4, which is currently in preparation under the EU IPA II Multicountry Programme.
