**WP 4: Competency Development:  
Workshop on State Safety Programme (SSP)**

Within the framework of the EU-funded Eastern Partnership and Central Asia Project (EaP/CA), a workshop on the State Safety Programme was delivered in Kiev on 04 and 05 September 2018. It was addressed to the National Safety Committee (Management Board) representing the different entities in charge of civil aviation in Ukraine.

The objective of this workshop was to promote a management system approach with a view to secure engagement of senior managers for SSP implementation in Ukraine. This entailed discussing the benefits of safety risk management at State level, presenting critical success factors, as well as principles for risk- and performance based

resource targeting & action planning at State level. The workshop also allowed promoting the benefits of regional cooperation on the basis of the EASP and EPAS.

SAAU experts shared with EASA the steps they are taking to adapt the ICAO and EU requirements to the particular context of a State such as Ukraine, and to get the second edition of their SSP document approved.

16 aviation professionals from the SAAU and state institutions attended the workshop.
