Work package 4
Training on EU Regulation 785/2004 (insurance)



Within the framework of the EU-funded Eastern Partnership and Central Asia Project (EaP/CA), a three-day workshop on EU Regulation 785/2004 (insurance) was delivered from 16th to 18th October 2019, in Tbilisi, Georgia.

The workshop provided to participants an in-depth view of the law and the mechanics of aviation insurance. Starting from a general view on insurance as a means of risk transfer, the term “Aviation Insurance” was analysed, as well as the various stakeholders obtaining different coverages of aviation insurance. The workshop aimed at creating an understanding by the participants for the need for insurance from a legal and from an economical point of view.

The activity was attended by nine (9) subject matter experts from Armenia, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine.
