WP 4: Competency Development:
“CAMO / Licenced Air Carriers”



Within the framework of the EU-funded EASA-EaP/CA project in the Eastern Partnership and Central Asian countries, a training on CAMO / Licenced Air Carriers was delivered from 19 to 20 April 2018 in Minsk.

The course was designed to develop and refine the competencies of those involved in aircraft continuing airworthiness management and Continuing Airworthiness Management Organisation (CAMO) related issues in the case of air carriers licenced in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1008/2008.

The activity enabled all participants to achieve a better understanding of continuing airworthiness requirements and the functions and the role of the continuing airworthiness management organisation.

8 civil aviation professionals from 4 EaP CAA's attended the course.
