Within the framework of the EU-funded Eastern Partnership and Central Asian Project, an EASA organised workshop on occurrence reporting and safety risk management was delivered for the experts of the Eastern Partnership countries, in the EASA headquarters in Cologne, from 13 to 14 March 2018.

The overall objective of this workshop was to strengthen the capacity of the countries' aviation administration staff in the domain of safety analysis and safety risk management.
