WP 3: Competency Development: Workshop on Aerodrome Certification and Conversion of Certificates

Within the framework of the EU-funded EASA-IPA3 programme on aviation safety in the Western Balkans and Turkey, a workshop on aerodrome certification and conversion of certificates was delivered in Sarajevo from 04 to 05 October 2016.

The overall objective of this interactive workshop was to strengthen the capacity of the aeronautical authorities of the EASA-IPA3 beneficiary countries in the aerodrome domain.

The workshop encompassed various aspects including: the EU safety aviation regulatory system, principles and relationship with the ICAO critical elements, a refresher on aerodrome rules and conversion versus certification, ICAO standards and recommended practices versus local regulatory framework, management system of the competency authority, establishment of an aerodrome certification basis and the flexibility tools, case studies and practical examples on deviations, as well as implementation of EU Regulation 139/2014 from the perspective of two EU Member States. Furthermore, information was provided on the future development of the EASA aerodrome rules.

The project brought together EASA experts and experts from the aeronautical authorities to exchange experience and best practice. Seventeen (17) civil aviation aerodrome professionals from the beneficiary countries attended the course.
