### **WP 3: Competency Development**

#### **Workshop “From Safety Data to Safety Risk Management”**

Within the framework of the EU-funded EASA-IPA3 programme on aviation safety in the Western Balkans and Turkey, an on-site workshop on occurrence reporting and safety risk management was delivered for the experts of the CAA-MK, in Skopje, from 25 to 27 October 2016.

This on-site support activity encompassed the requirement to collect and analyse safety data, the different types of safety analysis and the safety risk management process, the current situation in the national system of the CAA-MK, as well as future developments and requirements.

The project brought together EASA experts and aviation experts from the aeronautical administrations of the country to exchange experience and best practice.

The overall objective of this workshop was to strengthen the capacity of the aeronautical administration staff of the country in the domain of safety analysis and safety risk management.

Twenty two (22) civil aviation professionals from the CAA-MK attended the course.
