

# INSTRUCTIONS

## Information to be entered into Export Certificate of Airworthiness (EASA Form 27):

- Field 1**      Enter aircraft type and model
- Field 2**      Enter engine model
- Field 3**      Enter the name of aircraft manufacturer
- Field 4**      Enter propeller model; if not applicable state "N/A"
- Field 5**      For new aircraft enter the manufacturer POA number; for used aircraft state "N/A"
- Field 6**      For new aircraft enter the attached EASA Form 52 number; for used aircraft state "N/A"
- Field 7**      Enter serial number of the aircraft
- Field 10**     Enter the name of the state to which the aircraft is exported
- Field 11**     Enter any remarks / exemptions,"import requirements" text
- Note 1:      When new aircraft exported to USA, Field 11 should contain the following statement:

*"The [insert aircraft MODEL] covered by this certificate conforms to the type design approved under U.S. Type Certificate Number [INSERT TYPE CERTIFICATE NUMBER and REVISION LEVEL], and is found to be in a condition for safe operation," and/or any other "import requirements" text as specified in the U.S. type certificate data sheet.*
