Background: On the dates mentioned in the table above EASA (respectively LBA-Germany) issued the specified authorisations to SENNHEISER ELECTRONIC GmbH & Co. KG (Sennheiser).

In 2015 Sennheiser informed EASA about their intention to withdraw from the business with ETSO authorised articles.



On 18 November 2015 Sennheiser announced to the public "Sennheiser withdraws from the cockpit – ATC business remains. [...] Sennheiser is to withdraw from the pilots' headset business from March 2016. The company will fulfil all its obligations for servicing and spare parts throughout the full guarantee period for its headsets. Headsets for the air traffic control (ATC) sector are not affected by this decision, [...]" For the full press release see:

The approval of the production organisation of Sennheiser (DE.21G.0101) ceased on 31 December 2019.

On 28 January 2020 Sennheiser confirmed the intention to surrender all existing ETSO and JTSO Authorisations, as indicated in the table above, as well as to surrender the company ADOA (EASA.AP174).

In accordance with Article 19 (1) (d) of Regulation (EU) No 2018/1139, EASA accepted Sennheiser request to surrender on 31 March 2020. Upon that date, the authorisations listed above became ineffective pursuant to Article 21A.619 (a) (4) of the Annex (Part 21) to Commission Regulation (EU) No 748/2012.

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
