1. Issue and reasoning for regulatory change

The Agency has issued certification specifications for standard changes and repairs (CS-STAN) in order to facilitate implementation of standard changes (refer to 21.A.90B) and standard repairs (refer to 21.A.431B) in accordance with Part-21 (Annex I to Regulation (EU) No 2012/748¹).

CS-STAN will need to be amended on a regular basis.

2. Objectives

This rulemaking task (RMT.0690) intends to regularly amend CS-STAN, taking into account the principles of efficiency and proportionality.

CS-STAN will be regularly amended on the basis of lessons learnt and proposals submitted by affected stakeholders, as well as industry technological innovations, which can bring safety benefits in a cost-efficient manner. This includes introducing new standard changes and repairs, updating the scope of some of the existing standard changes or repairs, or removing some standard changes and repairs, as necessary.

Because of the generic nature of this RMT, this ToR remains open and has no end date. Each individual NPA will, however, provide the specific timescales of the subsequent deliverables (e.g. the intended ED decision publication date).

3. Activities

On a regular basis:

- select items eligible for introduction in CS-STAN and meeting the criteria of the objectives above;
- publish an NPA proposing an amendment of CS-STAN;
- prepare a comment-response document (CRD) to the above-mentioned NPA; and
- publish the CRD together with an ED Decision amending CS-STAN.

4. Deliverables

- An NPA describing the items that have been selected and proposing an amendment of CS-STAN;
- a CRD to the NPA; and
- an ED decision amending CS-STAN.
