Background: The current Holder of Type Certificate (TC) EASA.A.188 has requested to surrender its TC to EASA as of 30 June 2009.

EASA hereby asks you to communicate the aforementioned request to any natural or legal person to which this surrender could be of direct and individual concern as well as to other possible interested persons. When doing so, EASA also asks you to inform them that comments must be made before 22 May 2009, including any expression of interest to take over the ownership of the aforementioned type certificate upon surrender, subject to showing competence to fulfil the necessary obligations of a TC Holder in accordance with the applicable rules.

After satisfactory evaluation of the request and taking into account the comments received, if no suitable new TC holder is identified, EASA will accept the aforementioned surrender and take the decision to revoke the TC of reference in accordance with the applicable EASA administrative procedures¹.

Once the TC is surrendered, EASA will not provide any support for the type, and aircraft will no longer be eligible for a Certificate of Airworthiness issued under EC Reg. 216/2008 and 1702/2003.
