Background: The STC 10066090 addresses the installation of a Trakkabeam A800 High

Intensity Searchlight System into Airbus Helicopter models AS 365 N2 or

AS 365 N3.

The STC was initially granted by EASA on 4 July 2018 to Phoenix Aerospace Ltd. Following the withdrawal of the United Kingdom (UK) from the European Union (EU), UK became the State of Design, however, the STC remained valid in EASA

Member States.

Following a transfer of the STC to the new holder Boggi Aeronautics S.r.l., EASA became again the State of Design. On 5 March 2024 EASA issued the STC to the

new STC holder.

In accordance with <u>TIP</u>² CAA UK/EASA, page 50, 4.2.1, 7th paragraph it is expected that the transferring Authority CAA UK will reissue (means: validate) the STC in the name of the new holder after the Competent Authority EASA has

issued its STC.
