WP 4: Competency Development: "Impact assessment (IA) training"



Within the framework of the EU-funded Eastern Partnership and Central Asian Project, a training course on impact assessment was held in Chisinau from 09 to 11 October 2018.

The overall objective of the training was to provide civil aviation experts of the Republic of Moldova with essential knowledge about the purpose of impact assessment, monitoring and evaluation at EU level.

Determining when and how a Member State action should be undertaken, reviewed or repealed is ultimately a political choice. The quality of these choices, however, can be improved if better regulation principles like impact assessment, monitoring, evaluation and consultation of stakeholders are followed when preparing,
