**WP 4: Competency Development:
Workshop on EU Reg. 95/93 Airport SLOT allocation**



Within the framework of the EU-funded Eastern Partnership and Central Asia Project (EaP/CA), a workshop on the European Council Regulation (EEC) No 95/93 on common rules for the allocation of slots at Community airports was delivered in Tbilisi, Georgia from 30th July till 1st August 2018.

The workshop aimed to provide an in-depth analysis of the applicable Regulation, how its adoption works in different European countries and a general information about how slot allocation works worldwide.

Another objective was to better understand how common rules for the allocation of slots at EU airports enable airlines access to congested European airports on the basis of principles of neutrality, transparency and non-discrimination, so as to ensure optimal utilization of airport capacity and to allow for fair competition.
