WP 4: Competency Development:**“Aerodrome Certification Training”**

The main objective of the course was to build the capacity of NAA Inspectors for identifying, and justifying the findings with regard to Aerodromes according to the applicable ICAO SARPs. Additionally, the second objective was to raise awareness of the European regulatory framework, as well as the approach followed by EASA for the aerodrome certification process.

The course was structured around PowerPoint presentations highlighting the main aspects of the regulatory framework. These presentations were complemented with case studies that sought to discuss real situations.

The proposed structure of the course provided a complete view of the certification process and helped future inspectors not only during the planning phase of the certification of an airport, but also during the process for justifying and categorizing the possible deficiencies found.

8 subject matter experts from the Civil Aviation Administrations of Belarus, Kazakhstan and Kyrgyzstan attended the training course.
