WP 4: Competency Development: Safety Inspector Personnel Licensing Course Astana, from 11 to 15 February 2019



A five day course was delivered by the project to improve knowledge, provide update and enhance the ability to adopt ICAO SARPs in the respective National Aviation Administrations.

This with the aim to update the participants on the ICAO PEL framework and to enhance their ability on the establishment and maintenance a CAA PEL system; to obtain knowledge testing services from an outside provider; manage a knowledge testing system; evaluate a license application for completeness and accuracy; determine if an applicant is eligible for the license sought; administer, grade and document the results of knowledge tests; conduct flight crew license skill tests;
