Support on Self-assessment based on ICAO protocol questions



Within the framework of the EU-funded EASA - IPA4 project, on-site support on self-assessment based on ICAO protocol questions was provided to the Civil Aviation Authority of Kosovo¹ (CAAK) from 25 to 29 March 2019.

The main objective of the support visit was to deliver presentations on the overall ICAO Universal Safety Oversight Audit Programme Continuous Monitoring Approach (USOAP CMA), Critical Elements (CEs), use of compliance Check-Lists (CCs) and Protocol Questions (PQs) for CAAK technical personnel involved in the activity.

The second objective was to support and coach the CAAK technical team in terms of facilitation of the process and best practices in performing self-assessments based on ICAO Protocol Questions in the ORG, OPS, AGA and ANS domains.

CAAK was provided with set of recommendations aimed to further develop a safe and sustainable civil aviation system.
