Within the framework of the EU-funded Eastern Partnership and Central Asian Project, an interactive workshop on Performance-based Environment (PBE), safety culture and SMS was held at EASA’s headquarters in Cologne from 19 to 22 June 2018.

The overall objective of the workshop was to enhance the understanding of PBE and to discuss its practical application in oversight as well as to develop practical competence in the application of Safety Culture, enabling participants to confidently implement such culture within their organisation. Nine professionals from the civil aviation administrations of Armenia, Georgia, the Republic of Moldova and Ukraine attended the course.
