Within the framework of the EU-funded Eastern Partnership and Central Asian Project, the Third Steering Committee Meeting was held in Astana, Kazakhstan on 27 June 2018.

In total 17 representatives of aviation authorities from Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Moldova and Ukraine, as well as representatives of important EASA partner organisations, including the European Civil Aviation Conference (ECAC) – responsible for implementation of the security component of the project – and the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO), attended the event. Belarus, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan were officially apologised.

The Steering Committee took stock of the progress made within five Work Packages addressing the following issues: (1) EU legislation (for Eastern Partnership countries); (2) Administration (Oversight system); (3) Safety Management Systems, (4) Competence development, and (5) Cargo and Mail Security.

The working papers covering safety and security activities carried out under the different Work Packages were presented and a work programme for the coming period was agreed.
