**WP 4: Competency Development:
“Training on Part-145, Part-M, Part-66 and Part-147”**



A seven-day training on EASA Part-145, Part-M, Part-66 and Part-147 was implemented in Chisinau, Moldova from 19 to 27 June 2018.

This activity provided participants with the basic core competencies required of an Airworthiness regulator. Trainees acquired knowledge of safety regulations related to Continuing Airworthiness process and procedures, as well as a greater understanding of best practices for demonstrating compliance and regulating their industry.

The course was given in the form of classroom working sessions including presentations, several case studies, group exercises and discussions, providing both the theoretical and practical knowledge needed by new airworthiness inspectors in the
