WP 4: Competency Development: "Impact assessment (IA) training course" for the civil aviation administration of the Republic of Armenia

Within the framework of the EU-funded Eastern Partnership and Central Asian Project a training course on impact assessment was held in Yerevan from 14 to 16 May 2019.

The overall objective of the training was to provide civil aviation experts of the Republic of Armenia with essential knowledge about the purpose of impact assessment, monitoring and evaluation at EU level.

Determining when and how a Member State action should be undertaken, reviewed or repealed is ultimately a political choice. The quality of these choices, however, can be improved if better regulation principles like impact assessment, monitoring, evaluation and consultation of stakeholders are followed when preparing, implementing and evaluating policies, measures and financial programmes. These principles are simply good management principles.

The training provided theoretical notions and practical exercises. The tools that were explained could be adapted to the authority's need: in this regard, part of the time was dedicated for a case study customised for the participants.

The core modules of the course covered the following items:

- Steps of IA Methodology
- How is IA integrated in EASA
- Tools to support IA
- Best Intervention Strategy and Evaluation
- Case Study

7 civil aviation professionals from the Republic of Armenia attended the training course.
