Evaluation of progress with regards to the transposition/implementation (e.g. translation performed, implementation plan developed and current status of implementation) of each of the applicable aviation acquis according to the CAA-A; 4. Identification of remaining EU aviation legislation stemming from the mutually agreed, signed CAA-As; Development of the action plan (Roadmaps) per country addressing specific country needs and their commitment for the transposition/implementation of particular regulation; 5. Identification and analysis of training and on the spot assistance needs per beneficiary country concerned to support competence development of staff being responsible for the transposition/implementation of CAA-A requirements;	in progress	First quarter of 2018
